The table edges should also be wiped clean before play commences. All equipment being used (Cues, balls, triangle, rest) must be cleaned with the sanitisers provided again prior to play commencing.</p> <p>Players should also use the hand sanitiser provided prior to and after any snooker session.</p> <p>To aid ventilation in the snooker room windows should be open, snooker door left open and the fan should be in use.
